## QAFCO-5 NEGOTIATIONS IN PROGRESS BETWEEN QATAR FERTILISER COMPANY AND SNAMPROGETTI

**DOHA, QATAR** – Qatar Fertiliser Company Limited ("QAFCO") is finalizing negotiations with Snamprogetti of Italy concerning the implementation of QAFCO-5 project, which will be set up as part of QAFCO's complex in Mesaieed Industrial City. The project will consist of two ammonia plants, with a combined daily production capacity of 4,400 tonnes per day (2,200 tonnes per day each) and a urea plant with a production capacity of 3,800 tonnes per day.

The negotiations are set to be concluded by the end of September 2007, and the contract signing is slated for the end of the current year.

The total cost of the project and its financing sources have not yet been fixed. However, the picture will probably become clear in the course of the next two months, Document Reference: QAFCO/PR/ 071001 Eng.DOCX
